

## DEFINITIONS / DIAGNOSIS

Axis II disorders, "difficult to help" patients.

= long-standing, rigid, "stable" pattern of behavior & inner experience that deviates markedly from the individual's culture and causes significant distress or impairment in social, occupational, other important areas of functioning. Not due to another disorder or substances.

• Diagnosis by DSM-IV General Criteria includes the above description + manifestation of patterns in 2 or more of the following areas:

- ① Cognition: ways of perceiving self/others/events
- ② Affect: range, intensity, lability, appropriateness
- ③ Interpersonal Functioning
- ④ Impulse control

+ onset of pattern seen in adolescence or early adulthood (long duration). Dx in adulthood.  
+ often egosyntonic: patients often don't have insight as to the dysfunctionality of their PD.

## Etiology

Personality traits = 50% from genetics + 25% from environment (cattive, birth order, etc.) + 25% from random causes (family, abuse hx, sex)

## CLASSIFICATION

Dx by DSM-IV-TR criteria.

CLUSTER A: odd, eccentric	CLUSTER B: dramatic, emotional	CLUSTER C: anxious, fearful
<p>① <b>PARANOID</b> ☹♂ &gt; ♀</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• persistent, inappropriate mistrust, hostile</li> <li>• guarded, tense, hypervigilant, blames others</li> <li>• ♂ &gt; ♀, ↑ h/o abuse in childhood</li> <li>② ↑ of suspicions, preoccup = unjustified doubts, reluctance to confide due to unwarranted fear, benign events/remarks → threatening, grudges, recurrent suspicions about spouse's fidelity</li> <li>③ → usually resistant to cog-behav Tx.</li> <li>• maintain respectful, unaffectionate style.</li> <li>• antipsychotic for acute decompensation</li> </ul> <p>② <b>SCHIZOID</b> ☺</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• cold, detached, aloof, "shut-in", "autistic PD"</li> <li>• ↑ h/o cold, neglectful childhood relationships</li> <li>② pervasive detachment from social relationships, 4+ of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ↓ desire/enjoys close relationships, chooses solitary activities</li> <li>• ↓ interest in social, pleasure in activities</li> <li>• ↓ close friends</li> <li>• indifferent to others' comments</li> <li>• cold, detached, flat.</li> <li>• use art/writing to ease into insight-oriented tx.</li> </ul> </li> <li>③ <b>SCHIZOTYPAL</b> ☺@</li> <li>• "weirdos", distortions w/o psychosis</li> <li>• related to Axis I schizophrenia, sim. bio traits.</li> <li>② pervasive social &amp; interpersonal deficits, ↓ close relationships &amp; 5+ of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ideas of reference, odd/magical beliefs, unusual perceptual experiences, odd thinking, suspicion/paranoia, affect, odd friends, odd &amp; cog-behav, structured, edu groups, anxiety, low dose antidepressants, charact.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<p>① <b>ANTISOCIAL</b> ☹♂ &gt; ♀, 18+y/o</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• "the psychopath", criminal, no empathy</li> <li>• ♂ &gt; ♀, ↑ conduct DD in childhood, dysfunctional parents</li> <li>② Disregard &amp; violation of others' rights since age 15 and 3+ of: defiance in social norms, lying, impulsivity, recklessness, irresponsibility, lack of remorse</li> <li>③ → confused settings (mil/prison?) to realize behaviors.</li> </ul> <p>② <b>BORDERLINE</b> ☺↔☺</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• unstable, dysfunctional attachment &amp; separation</li> <li>• most common (2-3% of the gen population), ↑</li> <li>• ↑ h/o dysfunctional mother, abuse, abandonment, inability to form stable sense of self.</li> <li>② Pervasive unstable relationships, self-mage, affects, impulsivity in early adulthood: 5+ of: frantic efforts to avoid abandonment, unstable relationships, identity disturbance, impulsivity, self-damage, mood instability, "emptiness" &amp; inappropriate anger, dissoci. sx's.</li> <li>③ → from stable tx relationship, dialectical behav. therapy, SSRIs</li> </ul> <p>③ <b>HISTRIONIC</b> ☺</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• "histrionic"; caricature of stereotypic femininity</li> <li>② Excessive emotionality &amp; attention seeking with 5+ of: needs to be ctr of attn, sexual/provocative behav., rapid mood shifting, attn to phys appearance, impersonalistic speech, theatrical, influenced by others</li> <li>③ → indiv. psychodynamic therapy</li> </ul> <p>④ <b>NARCISSISTIC</b> ☹→Mp.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>② pattern of grandiosity, need for admiration, lack of empathy, fantasies of worth, success/power/brilliance/beauty/love, sense of entitlement, interpersonally exploitative</li> <li>③ → indiv. psychodynamic, DCT</li> </ul>	<p>① <b>AVOIDANT</b> ☺</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• "phobic" character, dtx: social phobia!</li> <li>• parental or peer rejection or abuse</li> <li>② Social inhibition + feelings of inadequacy + hypersensitivity to neg eval + 4 or more avoid activities &amp; contact fr. fear of rejection or criticism, unwilling to get involved w/ people, brittle, fear of rejection, views self as weak, vulnerable</li> <li>③ → supportive consistency, social skill training</li> </ul> <p>② <b>DEPENDENT</b> ☺→</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• "clings"; over/under-indulgence in birth-age 2</li> <li>② Excessive need to be taken care of + submissive/clinging behavior + fears of separation + 5 or more of: needs reassurance, others take responsibility, dif initiating projects, excessive lengths to obtain nurturance, afraid of being alone or left alone.</li> <li>③ → careful, not over-protective tx to tself esteem, effectiveness, independence</li> </ul> <p>③ <b>OBSSESSIVE-COMPULSIVE</b> ☺</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• anal-retentive perfectionist w/ "control freak"</li> <li>• excessive parental control, criticism, chiding</li> <li>② Preoccupation &amp; orderliness, perfectionism, control, ↓ flexibility/openness/efficiency, and 4+ of: lose big picture due to preocc of details, perfectionism, interferes w/ task completion, workaholic, inflexible about morals/ethics/values, pack rat, reluctant to delegate, strict, rigid, stubborn</li> <li>③ → avoid excessive intellectualization, focus on feelings, esp. in cognitive tx.</li> </ul>
